

Landscape Painting with Oil or Acrylic

As I have received requests for teaching a winter painting in addition to the summer painting advertised, I plan to do a different season for each session. March 30th will be a **winter** painting, April 6th will be a **spring** painting and we will paint a **summer** scene on April 13th.

March 30th - WINTER PAINTING

MATERIALS LIST FOR OILS

CANVAS

I recommend 11 x 14 stretched canvas, canvas board or gessoed board

BRUSHES & TOOLS

Two No. 8 flat bristle brushes (or similar size)

Three (or more) No. 1 round or flat bristle brushes (or similar size)

One small palette knife

Your favorite palette, disposable paper palette, or styrofoam plate

MEDIUM

Bring your favorite medium for oils; Galkyd works for me. I also sometimes use a mixture of 1 part Darmar Varnish, 1 part Stand Oil and 4 parts Gum Turpentine

BRUSH CLEANING

I prefer odorless cleaner in a glass or metal container & a roll of paper towels

PAINTS

Bring your favorite brand:

- Titanium White
- Cadmium Yellow Light
- Yellow Ochre (or Naples Yellow)
- Cadmium Red Light
- Alizarin Crimson
- Burnt Sienna
- Burnt Umber
- Cobalt Blue and/or Cerulean Blue

➔ For **Acrylic paints**, substitute water for odorless brush cleaner, but bring same canvas, similar brushes and comparable acrylic paints.

April 6th - SPRING PAINTING

Materials needed are the same, but for paints, in addition to those listed above, include:

- Permanent Green Light (or similar bright green color)
- Sap Green
- though not necessary, feel free to bring any shade of purple you may already have.

April 13th - SUMMER PAINTING

Materials and paints needed are the same as *all* those listed above, but you can include Ultramarine Blue
