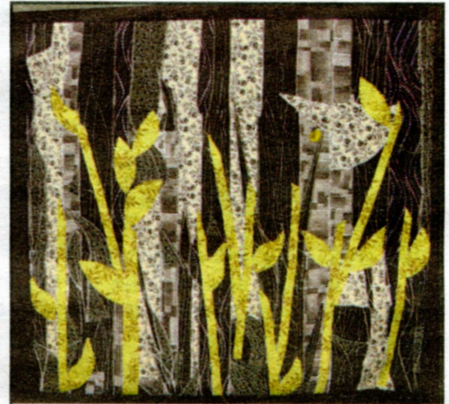
and does demos in PanPastels, watercolors, and using an iPad for art.

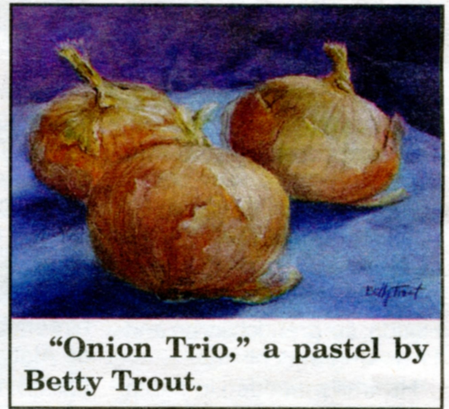
